Sixth grade EXPLORE classes are Band or Introduction to 6th grade during Semester I and 9 weeks each of Art & Computers during Semester II. Seventh grade classes are Art, Com- puters and Spanish. Eighth graders take Art, Industrial Arts and Spanish. All 7th & 8th grade EXPLORE classes are 12 weeks long.

7th & 8th grade students are currently in their 1st EXPLORE class of the 2013-14 school year. They will ro- tate to their 2nd class of the year on Monday, December 2nd.
