

READING INSTRUCTION

The District Administrator, working in conjunction with other administrators and appropriate instructional staff, including the certified reading specialist, shall propose for School Board approval a program of reading goals for grades kindergarten to 12. Such a proposal shall be submitted upon request by the Board or whenever the administration determines that it would be beneficial or prudent to revisit existing goals.

Following approval by the Board, the District's reading goals shall be a part of the District's annual evaluation of the reading curriculum and the District's regular assessment of reading-related needs across all instructional levels.
