

SCHOOL DAY AND CLOSING OF SCHOOL

The Board of Education authorizes the school day to be arranged and scheduled by the administration. It is to offer the maximum education for the time spent within the limitations of school facilities and the laws and regulations of the State.

The District Administrator or his/her designee shall have the authority to close, delay the opening, or dismiss school when such alteration in the regular session is required for the protection of the health and safety of students and staff members.

Announcements of emergency school closings, delays and early dismissals will be made over designated radio stations, television stations and through social media channels.

The District Administrator (or designee) shall develop other necessary plans for closing school and early dismissal. Inclement weather days shall be made up according to established procedures.
