### Solo & Ensemble

Over 50 RLMS students had the opportunity to participate in WSMA District Solo & Ensemble events at Rib Lake Middle & High Schools on March 23nd. Solo and Ensemble allows students to prepare for a goal of performance.

A qualified adjudicator evaluates each performance, giving both written and verbal comments to each performer. As part of their preparation, students studied in depth the composer, style of music and all of the musical and technical aspects of the piece that they prepared. Solo & Ensemble helps to build confidence, reinforces the value of preparation and hard work, and give students a feeling of satisfaction for a job well done.

In Choir; Out of 15 class C events, 14 received firsts & 1 received a second. Out of 2 class B events, both received seconds. Out of 2 class A events, 1 received a second and a special congratulations goes out to Trinity Taylor for receiving a starred first for her classical solo which advances her to state competition on Saturday, May 5, 2018.

In Band; Jacob Matyka on tenor saxophone & William Hartke on alto saxophone will also be advancing to state competition for their solos.

It is a rare occurrence for middle schoolers to earn the ability to perform at this level of competition.
