## Middle School SPORTS

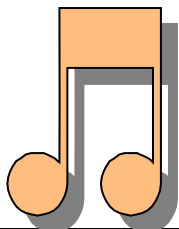

## Middle School MUSIC

All 6th grade students must take part in Band or Choir (they may take both) to fulfill a music requirement. 7th & 8th grade students do not have this requirement. Students will be scheduled in music classes per their choice. Any changes to a student's music schedule must be completed by the end of the first week of school. Changes require a note from the parent stating the change and reason for it. The teacher and principal will also need to sign the change request before the office can make an official change of schedule.
