FAFSA Parent Night

The FAFSA will be available to students to fill out starting October 1st. North-central Technical College Financial Aid representatives will be at RLHS on **Tuesday, October 30 at 6:30 pm** to host an informational meeting about the FAFSA. This meeting is open to all senior parents and students. The FAFSA is a form that is completed to help your student gain additional student aid through the access of loans, work study, and/or grants. NTC will also go through step by step on how to fill out the application. We will give parents and students the opportunity to fill out their FAFSA following the presentation at 7:30 pm. Please make sure you bring your 2017 taxes and a Chromebook with you if you plan to complete your FAFSA on the 30th. If you have any questions, please contact Mrs. Rhodes.

National Honor Society Selection Process

Seniors eligible for Rib Lake High School National Honor Society must meet the following criteria:

- Earn a 3.5 GPA at the beginning of their Senior year.
- Demonstrate positive character, leadership, and community service.



Seniors who meet the GPA criteria are scored (10 to 1) by the high school faculty based on their character, leadership and service. Students must obtain a minimal score of 6 to have their application considered by the faculty senate. The faculty senate then determines which students will be admitted into the National Honor Society.

Eligible students will soon find out if they have been chosen to become members. The induction ceremony for new and current members will be on November 5th at 7:00 pm.

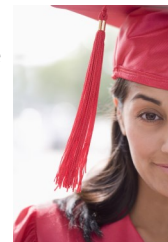
Important Reminder of UW College Admission Process

Seniors: all colleges (UW, Tech, and Private) are now accepting all applications. Make sure you are getting your applications in early since many schools have a certain limit of students they can accept each year. You should be looking at Tuesday, November 20 as the date to have your applications in by. Students are responsible for ensuring their high school transcripts are sent to the college they are applying to. Mrs. Rhodes can assist with sending transcripts.



General Guidelines for Admission to UW Campuses:

The following is a general profile of admitted freshman for fall 2017. They are the middle 50% range, so 25% of admitted freshmen are above this range and 25% are below.
