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### The Need and the Solution

For the last several years, the Rib Lake School District has struggled with the dilemma of not having enough money to address ongoing and badly needed building maintenance at each school. Due to the dramatic reduction of State funding of Wisconsin public schools, the district has had little choice but to forgo building maintenance in order to meet more pressing budget needs.

The Board of Education has determined the time has come to deal with the many deferred maintenance needs before they become even bigger problems. This project will greatly improve the indoor air quality, safety of students, and improve the overall learning environment, while saving on utility and operating costs, as well. The Board has gone through a lengthy process to understand the scope of all the needs and then to prioritize those that must be addressed today. Shall the School District of Rib Lake, Taylor and Price Counties, Wisconsin borrow the sum of not to exceed \$4,000,000 for the public purpose of paying the cost of energy efficiency related improvements at District buildings and sites, including but not limited to HVAC, water heating, plumbing, electrical, and lighting improvements; building envelope and exterior improvements; roof repairs and replacement; biomass generator and boiler upgrades and/or replacement; and acquiring related furnishings, fixtures and equipment by issuing its general obligation promissory note (or notes) under Section 67.12(12) of the Wisconsin Statutes?
