





SUBJECT AREA SCORE




3RD GRADE ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

BEHAVIOR



NURTURING RELATIONSHIPS

Rib Lake Elementary School builds strong connections between staff members and each child that enters our doors. Children are known and greeted by name.

BRAIN-BASED LEARNING

Children learn best with physical activity breaks. Physical Education is offered 4 days a week, and 45–60 minutes of recess is offered daily to all elementary school students.





POSITIVE CULTURE


Children are taught the routines and expectations of the school. They are provided opportunities to learn about and practice positive decisionmaking skills.
