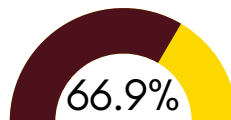

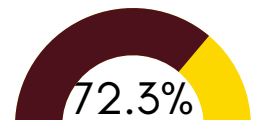
GPA

reaching the American middle class.*

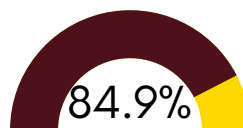
ALGEBRA II

college graduation.*

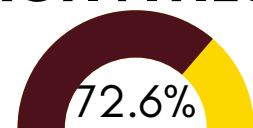
BEHAVIOR

participants were expected to do so.*



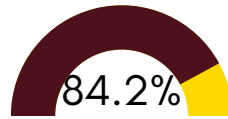

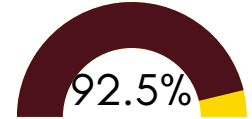

ATTENDANCE RATE



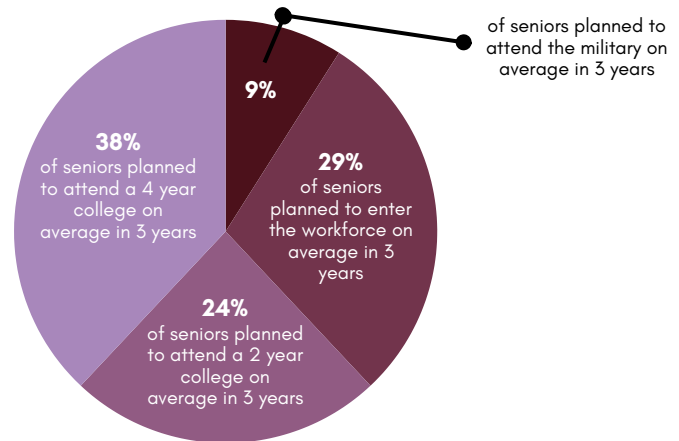

Freshman attendance rate is aligned to course success in high school and beyond.

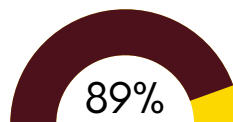
