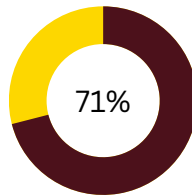

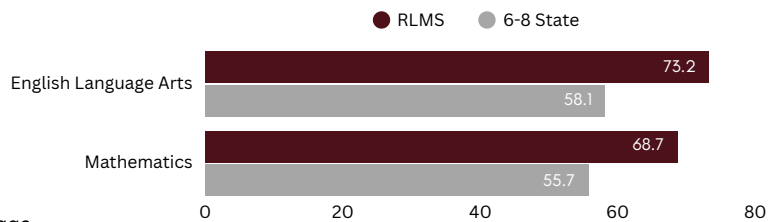

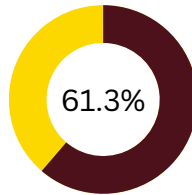


The score is a multi-year average of English Language Arts and mathematics sub-scores.

SUBJECT AREA SCORES

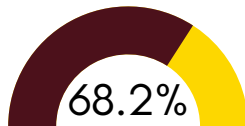
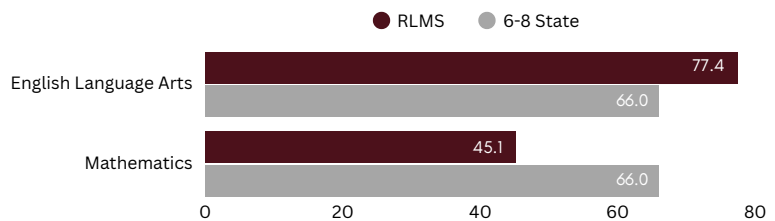

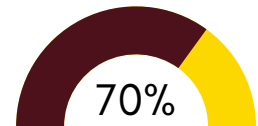


This priority area measures year-to-year student progress on statewide tests.

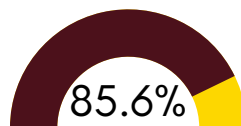

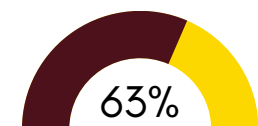
BEHAVIOR

- Spanish

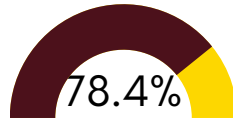
Students can take three years of band and/or choir

Students have the ability to take advanced high school math courses

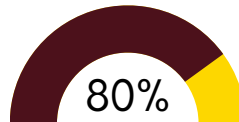

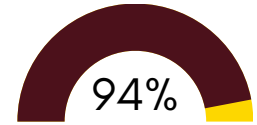

MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT

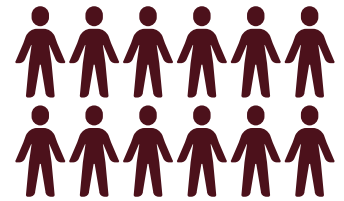
