- Since this class has limited enrollment, please do not register your child if they are unable to attend instruction most of the dates listed above.

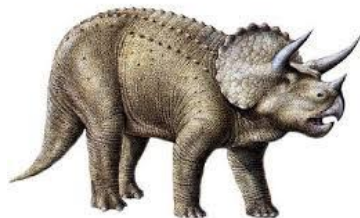
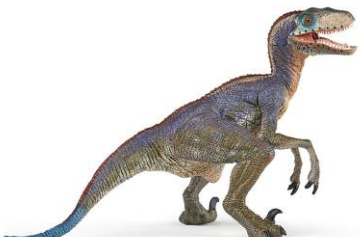
