COVID Relief Funding Draft Plan

The Rib Lake School District is publishing this draft plan concerning the use of Federal COVID Relief Funds in the amount of \$664,086. The funding would be broken into two fairly equal amounts to be used in the 2022-23 school year and the 2023-24 school year. All funds must be used by September of 2024.

Goal 1: Academic Achievement and Learning Support

The overall goal of this funding is to increase academic achievement, increase engagement, and support interventions to accelerate learning. This one-time funding will allow for a large increase in the purchase of curricular materials.

Goal 4: Maintaining Staffing and Initiatives

The 2021-23 state budget currently calls for no increase in Fund 10 revenue which will cap spending for most educational and support costs for the district to 2020-21 levels. The legislature and Governor enacted this budget due to the presence of COVID relief money given to schools. With this in mind, the district will use an amount of \$100,788 each year to cover the inflationary costs usually covered by the increase in the revenue cap.

Please Note: This proposal can be changed in the future with a public input period and Board action. The budget could be revised if the revenue limit changes due to a predicted surplus at the state level.
