

MANAGEMENT OF CONCUSSION IN THE SCHOOL SETTING

The Rib Lake School District is committed to ensuring the safety of students while at school and when participating in any school-sponsored events. The Rib Lake School District recognizes that educating key individuals, including students, student-athletes, parents, coaches, school administrators, athletic directors, teachers, athletic trainers, physicians, and other health care providers about prevention and early recognition of concussions remains the most important components of improving the care of students with concussions.

The Rib Lake School District is aware that head injuries, including concussions, can happen to any student, not just an athlete. Therefore the District has developed procedures to address head injuries that occur during the school day, during school sponsored events and during school sponsored athletic events. The District is committed to providing students who have experienced a concussion, a plan to return to school life.
