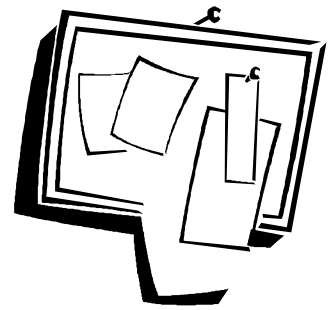


RLMS Announcements for Friday, April 11, 2014
