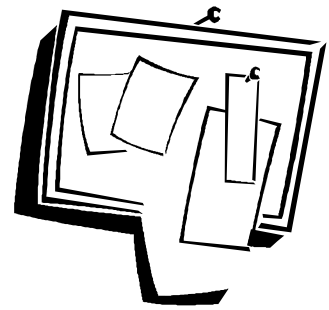


## RLMS Announcements for Friday, May 16, 2014
