Lumber Arrived June 6, 2024

























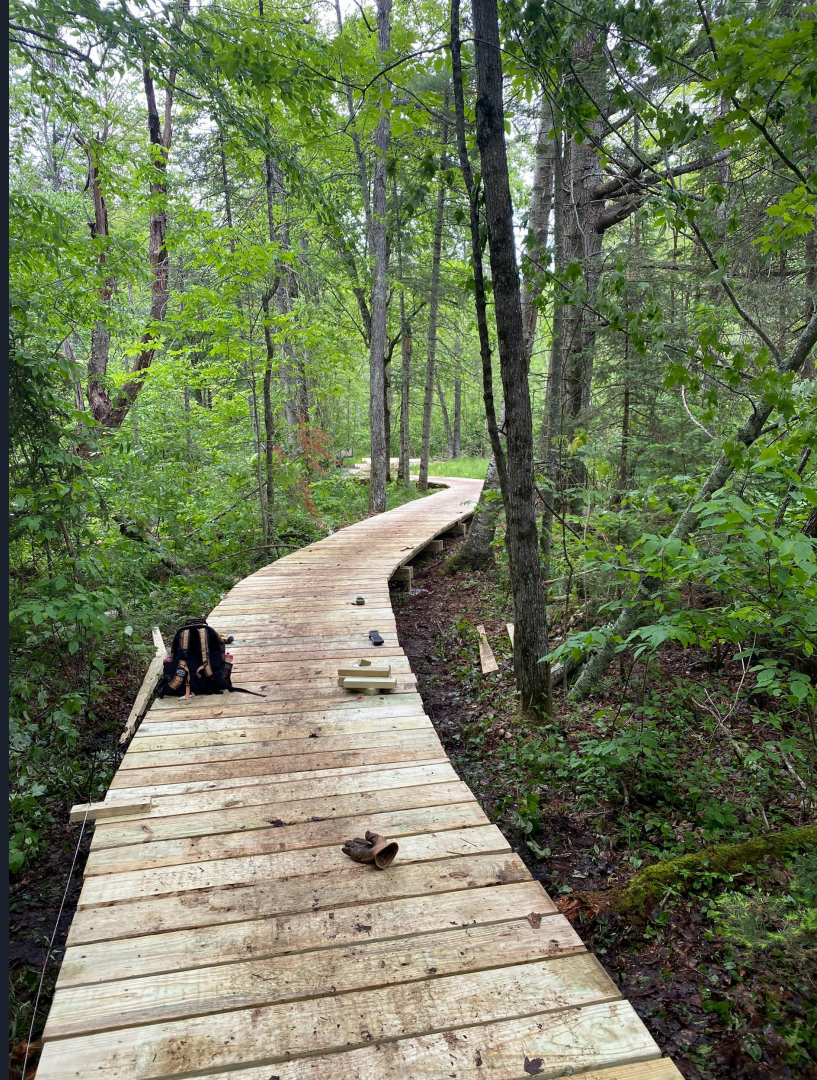






































Boardwalk was completed on July 29th

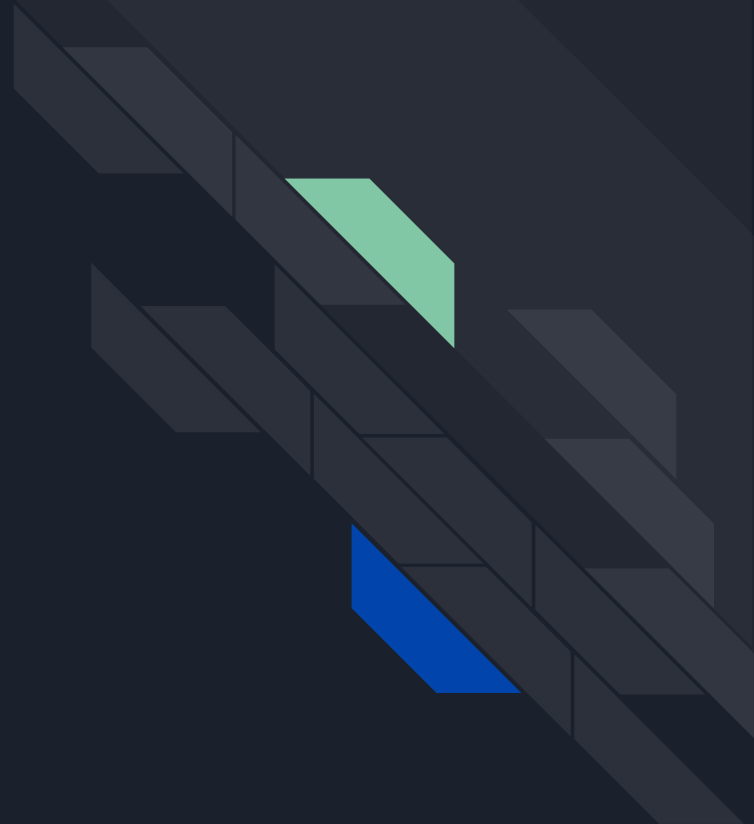
She visited from out of state, and our kids were so excited to take her on the new school forest trail! She was in awe that students here can have the outdoor experience.

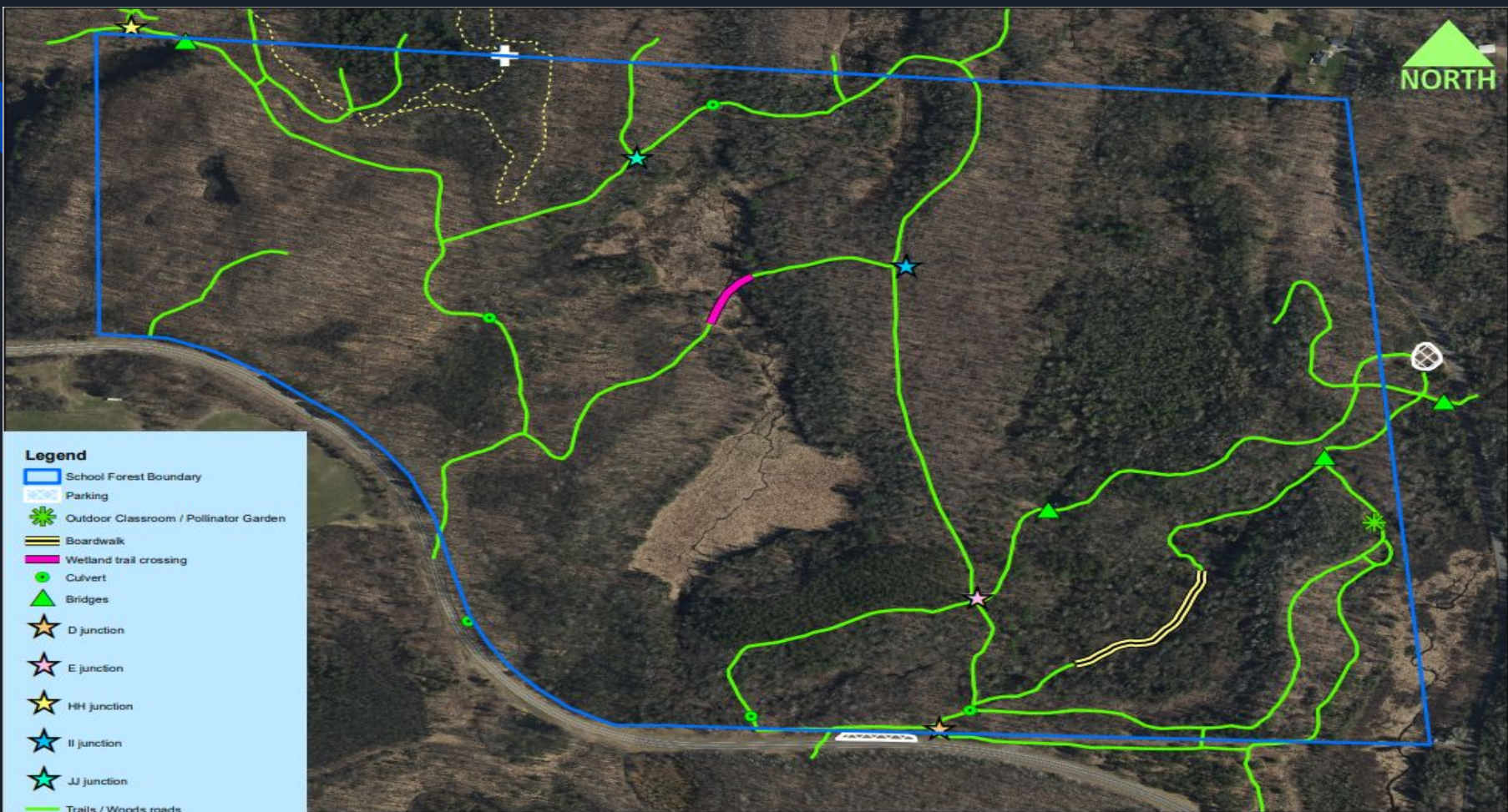

Estimates

To finish the project we need:

Trail to be graveled: Total \$7800

2 rolls of fabric at \$400 each= \$800

2000 feet of Blue granite trail 20 - 16 yard truck loads at \$350 a load= \$7000

Decking on the bridged: Total \$1453

30' by 12' treated decking = \$1375

Screws \$78
